Adopt a wreck Award 2010 Entry Criteria

Entries for the 'Adopt a Wreck Award 2010' are now invited from all participating groups. The judging panel (consisting of the Receiver of Wreck and representatives from the UK's major sport diving organisations) are seeking entries based on the following criteria. It is stressed these are not 'categories' and all will be judged on their merit.

- i. **A Milestone Report**, based on investigations to date or a particular aspect of a project.
- ii. **Completed Project**
- iii. **Annual submission** – previous winners are welcome to enter in subsequent years for different aspects of a project

The aim is not only to encourage more entries, but to encourage more dissemination – a key aim of the 'Adopt A Wreck' initiative.

One thing is worth emphasising that the Award will NOT be presented if, in the opinion of the panel, submissions are not to the standards set by previous winners.

All entries must be submitted using this form with supporting documentation where required. In the case of press/TV material, please submit these on suitable media (CD/DVD).

Please bear in mind that four judges are on the panel, and all would like to receive the material prior to the 'day of judgement'. Whilst 'paper copy' is perfectly acceptable, please consider the use of e-mail (bearing in mind that most e-mail addresses have a 5mb limit on files) and CDs/DVDs – this lessens the environmental impact and will certainly be cheaper through the mail.

At the completion of the panels' deliberations, all copies bar one (kept on file for record purposes) will be returned. In the case of images etc, all copyright and ethical property rights will be safeguarded.

IF YOU WIN - or are 'Runners Up'

The Award will be presented at the NAS Annual Conference, held in Portsmouth University on the 6th November 2010. We would obviously be delighted if you attend in person. The winning group will be asked to make a 20-25 minute presentation on their work during the afternoon session. Preferably this would be delivered via 'MS PowerPoint'. This presentation should be sent to the NAS office on memory stick, CD or DVD by 1st November 2010 (this will allow us to make sure it works with the suite's media unit!).
